From The Mayor's Desk

It is officially Fall in the Town of Welaka, and while the leaves are not changing (welcome to Florida), the nights are getting longer, and the days are getting cooler. Fall is my favorite time of the year because of all the great holidays that come with this time of year. This past Sunday, we kicked off the season with our 2nd Annual Spooky Golf Cart Parade and Trick or Treat Event in the park. We had over 500 ghosts and goblins in attendance, and over 50 golf carts participated in the parade. I want to Thank Courtney Desouza, Diana Gonsalez, and Wendy Wood of our Welaka Events Committee for working so hard to put this Event on for our Town. Events like this make Welaka a great place to live and raise a family.

The Events Committee is also preparing for our 2nd Annual Christmas on the River Event in Welaka on Saturday, December 10th. The Christmas Parade will start at Noon at the corner of CR 309 and Maxwell Drive, ending at the intersection of CR 309 and 308B at the red light. We also have several events before and after the parade that day at the Downtown Park, starting at 10:00 AM and going until 4:00 PM; you will be able to get some last-minute holiday shopping done with our craft vendors who will be set up in the park. Starting at 2:00 pm and going until 4:00 pm in Downtown Park, there will also be an opportunity for the children to meet Santa and receive a Christmas toy. Food Trucks will be in the park from 12:00 PM until 4:00 PM that day, along with DJ DR Doom of Iheart Radio, playing your favorite Christmas songs all afternoon. Finally, to close out the day's events, we will conclude with our annual lighted boat parade on the river at 6:00 PM. The boat parade will go from Sportsmans Harbor, on the North end, to River Bend Condos, on the South end of the Town. Spectators can view the boat parade at our Floating Dock at Bryant's Wharf, or visit one of our local eating establishments on the river in that area. Please come out and join in on all of the Christmas festivities this season in Welaka!

On a Welaka Police Department front, our Chief of Police Mike Porath has secured the state funding for a 3rd brand new Police car for the department, and we expect to take delivery of it very soon. He is also in the process of doing interviews to hire a 3rd full-time police officer for the Police Department. Several residents have questioned the need for a third full-time officer, and I have assured them that all three officers will not be working simultaneously. Our goal is to have night and weekend police presence, seven days a week in the Town. If you have an issue at 8:00 pm on a Thursday, it will be comforting to know you can call the Police and have a local officer right here in Welaka respond to your needs. Also, for anyone who lives on CR 309 or 308B, like me, I am sure you have witnessed a significant decrease in the speed of the vehicles. People are paying more attention to how fast they drive in Welaka. For those that worry about Welaka turning into a speed trap, that is not the case. The reality is that we have residents who walk and bike our streets and children who live and play in our community. We aim to slow vehicle traffic and ensure our residents are safe.

On the Town front, our Public Works Department is working on hanging Christmas lights to get the Town ready for the Christmas Season. They are also continuing to fix streets damaged by the recent storm as they spruce up the Town parks for the holidays. On the Utility Department side, we are working with the engineers to finalize the plans for our new Wastewater Treatment Plant designs as we make our plans to apply for grants and legislative appropriations in the coming year to update our stormwater drainage and pave streets in the Town.

As we prepare to close out 2022 in the Town of Welaka, it continues to be an honor and privilege to serve as your Mayor. The things we have accomplished in our Town this year are nothing short of amazing. While I was a part of it, I can not take sole credit for it because it continues to be a combined effort of our Town Staff, Town Council, Board Volunteers, and Town residents, all working to move Welaka forward together. Until next month, I hope everyone has a safe and happy Thanksgiving, and I look forward to seeing everyone at our Christmas Celebration in December.




